- Open to graduates regardless of major who have a quantitative foundation with an interest in building a career in Analytics

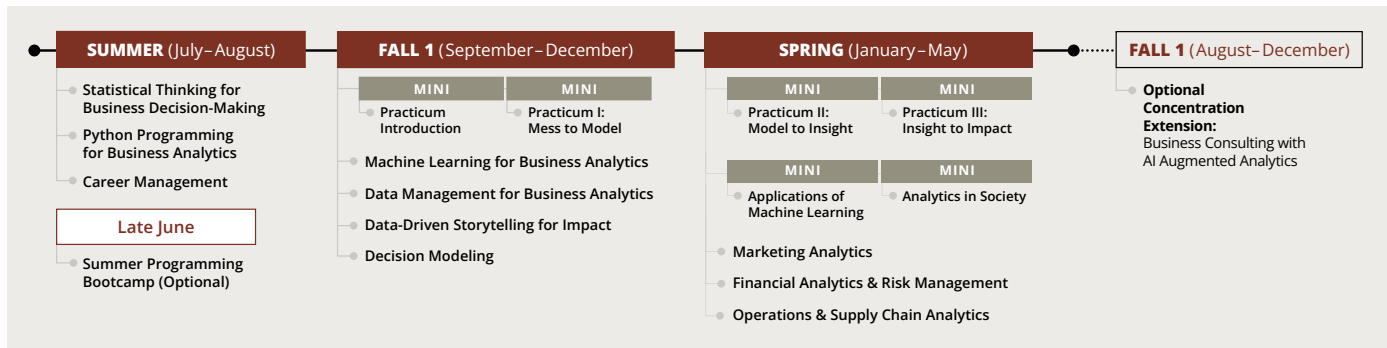
Tuition, Fees, & Financial Aid
